AN ACT concerning County Courts and amending section 2A:3-13 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 2A:3-13 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 2A:3-13. There shall be a judge of each County Court; and in addition,
4 the Governor may, whenever in his judgment the public interest requires,
5 appoint additional judges, as follows:

6 a. In counties now or hereafter having 900,000 or more inhabitants, 11
7 additional judges, making 12 in all in each of such counties.

8 b. In counties now or hereafter having not less than 700,000 nor more
9 than 900,000 inhabitants, 7 additional judges, making 8 in all in each of such
10 counties.

11 c. In counties now or hereafter having not less than ***[430,000]*** *400,000*
12 nor more than 700,000 inhabitants, 5 additional judges, making 6 *in all* in each
13 of such counties.

14 d. In counties now or hereafter having ***[260,000]*** *150,000* or more and
15 less than ***[430,000]*** *400,000* inhabitants, 3 additional judges, making 4 in
16 all in each of such counties.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

17 ***[e.]** In counties now or hereafter having more than 150,000 and less than
18 260,000 inhabitants other than counties of the fifth class, **[an]** 2 additional
19 **[judge]** *judges*, making **[2]** 3 in all in each of such counties.*

20 ***[f.]** **e.** In counties bordering on the Atlantic ocean and now or here-
21 after having not less than 50,000 nor more than 100,000 inhabitants, an addi-
22 tional judge, making 2 in all in each of such counties.

23 ***[g.]** **f.** In counties of the fifth class, 3 additional judges, making 4 in
24 all.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
