STATEMENT to S 245 (1949)

The purpose of this bill is to protect the public health, safety and general welfare and eliminate the hazards arising from careless and inefficient dispensing of gasoline and other inflammable liquid. The Commissioner of Labor and Industry, by a directive, has declared the operation of a gasoline station to be hazardous. Ten States have banned the sale of gasoline by automatic dispensing machines as detrimental to the public welfare. The procedure for the enforcement of the act is in accordance with the uniform "The Penalty Enforcement Law" enacted last year (P. L. 1948, c. 253).
