12 operated by boards of education and such other certificates as it shall
13 be authorized to issue by law based upon certified scholastic records
14 or upon examinations, or both, and such credentials as may be required
15 to serve as a substitute teacher or a substitute school nurse, and may
16 revoke the same under rules and regulations prescribed by the State
17 board. A fee of not less than \$20.00 shall be charged for the issuance
18 of every certificate and credential as prescribed by such rules and

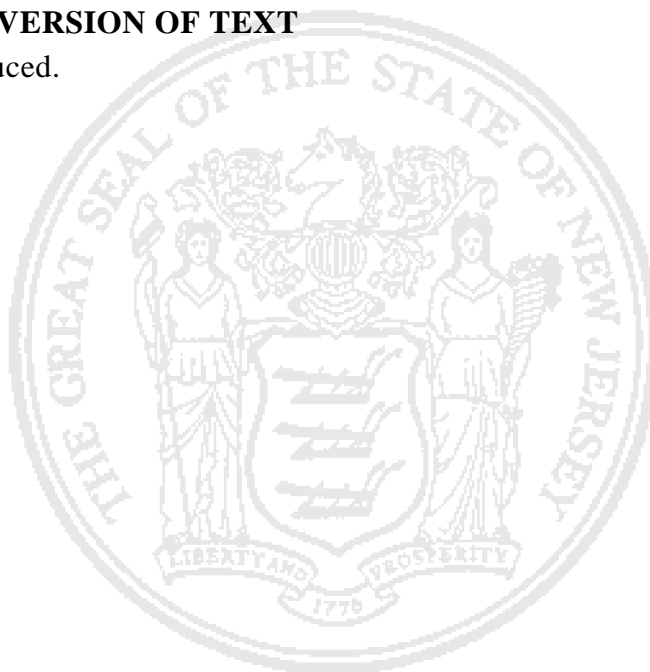
