1 AN ACT to rename the Senator Garrett W. Hagedorn Center for
2 Geriatrics and amending and supplementing R.S.30:1-7 and
3 R.S.30:4-160.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the
6 State of New Jersey:

7 1. R.S.30:1-7 is amended to read as follows:
8 R.S.30:1-7. The long-term care facilities, institutions, and
9 psychiatric facilities of this State, within the meaning of this
10 Title, shall include the following, and, as well, any facilities
11 established hereafter for any similar purpose:

12 Trenton Psychiatric Hospital,
13 Greystone Park Psychiatric Hospital,
14 Marlboro Psychiatric Hospital,
15 Ancora Psychiatric Hospital,
16 Senator Garrett W. Hagedorn [Center for Geriatrics]
17 Gero-Psychiatric Hospital,
18 The Forensic Psychiatric Hospital,
19 North Princeton Developmental Center,
20 North Jersey Developmental Center,
21 New Lisbon Developmental Center,
22 Woodbine Developmental Center,
23 Vineland Developmental Center,
24 Woodbridge Developmental Center,
25 Hunterdon Developmental Center,
26 [Developmental Center at Ancora,
27 New Jersey Memorial Home for Disabled Soldiers at Menlo
28 Park,
29 New Jersey Memorial Home for Disabled Soldiers, Sailors,
30 Marines and their Wives and Widows at Vineland,]

34 2. R.S.30:4-160 is amended to read as follows:
35 R.S.30:4-160. 30:4-160. The New Jersey State Hospitals,
36 designated in R.S.30:1-7 as psychiatric hospitals, shall include the
37 existing buildings and lands of Ancora Psychiatric Hospital,
38 Greystone Park Psychiatric Hospital, Marlboro Psychiatric
39 Hospital, Senator Garrett W. Hagedorn [Center for Geriatrics]
40 Gero-Psychiatric Hospital, Trenton Psychiatric Hospital and The
41 Forensic Psychiatric Hospital, and all grounds or places where the
42 patients thereof may from time to time be maintained, kept,
43 housed or employed.

The Assembly Health and Human Services Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 879.

This bill renames the Senator Garrett W. Hagedorn Center for Geriatrics in Glen Gardner Borough, Hunterdon County, as the Senator Garrett W. Hagedorn Geriatric-Psychiatric Hospital in order to better reflect the mission of that institution.

In addition, this bill updates the list of facilities within the Department of Human Services (DHS) by deleting references to facilities which are either closed or transferred to another department, and reconciles the inconsistencies presented by the enactments of P.L.1987, c.116 and P.L.1988, c.138. This will create a complete list of DHS facilities in R.S.30:1-7 separate from the list of correctional facilities in section 8 of P.L.1976, c.98 (C.30:1B-8).

This bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 2722 of 1993 (Lance/Kamin), which the Assembly Education Committee reported during the 1992-93 session. The bill passed the Assembly but was not reported from committee in the Senate.

This bill is also identical to Senate Bill No. 448 (Littell), which is currently pending in the Senate Health Committee.

This bill was prefiled for introduction in the 1994-95 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
