AN ACT concerning leave of absence from public employment and
amending R. S. 38:23-2.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 38:23-2 is amended to read as follows:
2 38:23-2. The head of every public department and of every court
3 of this State, every superintendent or foreman on the public works
4 of this State, the heads of the county offices of the several counties
5 and the head of every department, bureau and office in the govern-
6 ment of the various municipalities, shall give a leave of absence
7 with pay to every person in the service of the State, county or mu-
8 nicipality who is a duly authorized representative of the Grand
9 Army of the Republic, United Spanish-American War Veterans,
10 Disabled American Veterans of the World War, Veterans of
11 Foreign Wars, Ladies Auxiliaries of Veterans of Foreign Wars,
12 Ladies Auxiliary, Veterans of World War I of the U. S. A., Ameri-
13 can Gold Star Mothers, Indian War Veterans, American Legion,
14 American Legion Auxiliary, Jewish War Veterans of the United
15 States, Ladies Auxiliary, Department of New Jersey, Jewish War
16 Veterans of the U. S. A., Catholic War Veterans of the United
17 States, Ladies Auxiliary of New Jersey State Department, Catholic
18 War Veterans, The 369th Veterans Association, Incorporated,

27 United States Coast Guard Auxiliary, Navy League, Veterans of
28 World War I of the United States of America, Polish Legion of
29 American Veterans, Polish Legion of American Veterans, Ladies
30 Auxiliary, the Italian American War Veterans of the United States,
31 Incorporated, [and] the Ladies Auxiliary, Italian American War
32 Veterans of the United States, Incorporated, *[and]* the New
33 Jersey Firemen's Association *and the New Jersey State Exempt
33A Firemen's Association*, to attend any State or national conven-
34 tion of such organization.

35 A certificate of attendance to the State convention or encamp-
36 ment shall, upon request, be submitted by the representative so
37 attending.

38 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration
39 of the convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to travel
40 to and from the convention. No person shall be entitled to a total
41 of more than 5 days leave of absence with pay each calendar year
42 for the purpose of attending, as authorized representative, the
43 State or national convention of one or more of the above enumer-
44 ated organizations. The leaves of absence authorized hereunder
45 shall not be cumulative and any unused leaves shall be canceled at
46 the end of any given year.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

The purpose of this bill is to add the New Jersey Firemen's Association and the New Jersey State Exempt Firemen's Association to the list of those organizations whose members are eligible for leaves of absence with pay from the service of the State, county or municipality, pursuant to R. S. 38:23-2, to attend, as duly authorized representatives, any State or national convention of their organizations.
