4 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the*
5 *State of New Jersey:*

6 ¹[1. Section 1 of P.L.1977, c.347 (C.40A:14-77) is amended to
7 read as follows:

8 1. The heads of the county offices of the several counties and
9 the head of every department, bureau and office in the
10 government of the various municipalities shall give a leave of
11 absence with pay to every person in the service of the county or
12 municipality who is a duly authorized representative of the New
13 Jersey State Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc., Fraternal
14 Order of Police, American Federation of Police Officers, Inc.,
15 Bronze Shields, Inc., Batons, Vulcan Pioneers, a member
16 organization of the New Jersey Council of Charter Members of
17 the National Black Police Association, Inc., Italian American
18 Police Society of New Jersey, Firemen's Mutual Benevolent
19 Association, Inc., the Uniformed Firemen's Association, or the
20 New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police, to attend any
21 State or national convention of such organization.

22 A certificate of attendance to the State convention shall, upon
23 request, be submitted by the representative so attending.

24 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration
25 of the convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to
26 travel to and from the convention.

7 1. Section 1 of P.L.1977, c.347 (C.40A:14-77) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 1. The heads of the county offices of the several counties and
10 the head of every department, bureau and office in the
11 government of the various municipalities shall give a leave of
12 absence with pay to every person in the service of the county or
13 municipality who is a duly authorized representative of the New
14 Jersey State Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc., Fraternal
15 Order of Police, American Federation of Police Officers, Inc.,
16 Bronze Shields, Inc., Batons, Vulcan Pioneers, a member

34 This bill would entitle local law enforcement officers to leaves
35 of absence with pay to attend a State or national convention of
36 the Italian American Police Society of New Jersey as a duly
37 authorized representative.

38 Under current law, local governmental units are required to
39 grant leaves of absence with pay to any employee who attends a
40 State or nation convention of the New Jersey State Patrolmen's
41 Benevolent Association, the Fraternal Order of Police, American
42 Federation of Police Officers, Inc., Bronze Shields, Inc., Batons,
43 Vulcan Pioneers, a member organization of the New Jersey

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: OCTOBER 22, 1992

The Senate Law and Public Safety Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 1106 with amendments.

As amended, this bill would entitle a corrections officer who is a member of the Italian American Police Society of New Jersey to a leave of absence with pay to attend, as a duly authorized representative, a State or national convention of the organization.

Under current law, a leave of absence with pay must be granted to every civil service employee who is a duly authorized representative of the New Jersey Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc., Fraternal Order of Police, Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association, Inc., the Fire Fighters Association of New Jersey or the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police to attend any State or national convention of the organization. The leave of absence would be for the duration of the convention with a reasonable time allowed for travel to and from the convention. Under current law, a person may be required to submit a certificate proving that he attended the convention.

Prior to amendment, the bill would have entitled a local law enforcement officer to a leave of absence with pay to attend, as a duly authorized representative, a State or national convention of the Italian American Police Society of New Jersey.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: JANUARY 25, 1993

The Assembly Appropriations Committee reports favorably Senate Bill No. 1106 (1R).

Senate Bill No. 1106 (1R) entitles a corrections officer who is a member of the Italian American Police Society of New Jersey to a leave of absence with pay to attend, as a duly authorized representative, a State or national convention of the organization. Currently, a leave of absence with pay must be granted to each civil service employee who is a duly authorized representative of the New Jersey State Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc., the Fraternal Order of Police, the Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association, Inc., the Fire Fighters' Association of New Jersey, or the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police to attend a State or national convention of the employee's organization.

The leave of absence with pay to attend, as a duly authorized representative, a State or national convention of the Italian American Police Society of New Jersey will be for the duration of the convention plus a reasonable time allowed for travel to and from the convention. A certificate of attendance at the convention may be required of the representative.

This bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 1530 (1R).

FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill is not certified for a fiscal note. Granting of a paid leave of absence should not result in an additional employer cost for the employee granted leave. Additional employer costs incurred, if any, would be extra compensation as necessary for persons replacing the employees attending the convention, an amount difficult to predict and likely to be very small in relation to the total payroll of the employer.
