AN ACT to amend "An act concerning the County Courts, and supplementing chapter 3 of Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes," approved April 1, 1955 (P. L. 1955, c. 3).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

3 1. Section 1 of the act of which this act is amendatory is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 1. When the judge of a County Court, who is required by law
6 to devote his entire time to his judicial duties, is assigned to sit
7 temporarily without the county in and for which he is appointed
8 in the Superior Court or in a County Court, the county in and for
9 which he is appointed shall be entitled to reimbursement of **[\$75.00]**
10 *\$90.00* per day while he so sits. The reimbursement of the **[\$75.00]**
11 *\$90.00* per day for such services in the Superior Court shall be
12 made by the State Treasurer from the State treasury on claim by
13 the county entitled thereto approved by the administrative direc-
14 tor of the courts, and the reimbursement of the **[\$75.00]** *\$90.00*
15 per day for such services in a County Court shall be made by the
16 county treasurer from the county fund of the county in which the
17 services are rendered on the claim of the county entitled thereto
18 signed by the judge so serving.

19 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1968.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: MARCH 20, 1967

Assembly Bill No. 670 increases from \$75.00 to \$90.00 per day the amount a County Court judge shall receive when sitting out of county, effective January 1, 1968.

The Department of the Judiciary states that anticipated out-of-county assignments amount to approximately 250 days a year. Therefore, the additional cost to the State, if this legislation is enacted, would be \$1,875.00 in fiscal 1968 and \$3,750.00 in fiscal 1969.

In compliance with written request received, there is hereby submitted a fiscal estimate for the above bill, pursuant to P. L. 1962, c. 27.
