AN ACT concerning jury commissioners and amending N. J. S.
2A:68-7.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 2A:68-7 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:68-7. Each jury commissioner, except a jury commissioner
3 who holds the office of sheriff, shall receive *annual* compensation,
4 payable semimonthly by the ***[board of chosen freeholders]***
5 **governing body** of such county **[as follows]** *in such amount*
6 *within the following limitations as fixed by the board ***[board]****
7 **county**: **[\$900.00** per annum in counties of the first class; \$750.00
8 per annum in counties of the second class and counties of the
9 third class having a population in excess of 190,000; and \$500.00
10 per annum in all other counties.] *In counties having 600,000 or*
11 *more inhabitants, not less than \$900.00 nor more than \$2,000.00;*
11A *in counties having 400,000 or more and less than 600,000 in-*
12 *habitants, not less than \$750.00 nor more than \$1,750.00; in*
13 *counties having 190,000 or more and less than 400,000 inhabitants,*
14 *not less than \$750.00 nor more than \$1,500.00; in counties having*
15 *100,000 or more and less than 190,000 inhabitants, not less than*
16 *\$500.00 nor more than \$1,250.00; and in counties having less than*
17 *100,000 inhabitants, not less than \$500.00 nor more than \$1,000.00.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
