AN ACT authorizing counties to reimburse certain nonprofit or
charitable associations for certain costs incurred incidental to
the leasing of a county-owned facility.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Any county may appropriate an amount not to exceed
2 \$250,000.00 for payment to a nonprofit or charitable association
3 of all or part of any costs incurred in the renovation or improve-
4 ment of any building or structure owned by the county and leased,
5 for a term of 21 years at a nominal consideration, to said associa-
6 tion for use in the provision of health services. Any costs so in-
7 curred shall be reimbursable only to the extent that the renovations
8 or improvements have served to enhance the value of said building
9 or structure. The enhanced value due to such renovations or im-
10 provements shall be ascertained and certified to the board of chosen
11 freeholders of said county at the termination of the lease.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill allows any county in the State to make an appropria-
tion to certain nonprofit or charitable associations for part or all
of the costs incurred in the renovation or improvement of any
building or structure owned by the county and leased by such
association. Such costs shall be reimbursable only to the extent
that the renovations or improvements add to the value of the county
building or structure, but such payment shall in no instance be in
excess of the statutory limit.
