AN ACT concerning State employees and supplementing chapter 14
of Title 52 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. No employee of this State, or of any State agency or instru-
2 mentality, who is on approved vacation leave***[**, sick leave, or any
3 other type of leave of absence**]*** with pay***[,]*** on any day on which
4 the department, division, agency or other office within which he is
5 employed is officially closed due to inclement weather, hazardous
6 transportation conditions, a declaration of public mourning, or for
7 any other reason, shall be eligible to receive compensatory time off
8 granted in connection with such official closing in the form of any
9 type of leave of absence with pay.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: SEPTEMBER 25, 1978

The purpose of this bill is to prevent State employees who are on approved paid leave on a day when State offices are officially closed, due to weather conditions or for other reasons, from receiving compensatory time off granted to other State workers.

The committee amended the bill to restrict its application solely to approved vacation leave with pay. The aim of the bill is to provide uniform treatment of employees in the event of an unexpected closing of the State offices.
