INTRODUCED JANUARY 29, 1970

By Assemblymen HURLEY and CAFIERO

Referred to Committee on County and Municipal Government

AN ACT to amend "An act relating to, regulating and providing for the government of cities of the second class which now have or may hereafter have a population of less than 20,000," approved April 23, 1907 (P. L. 1907, c. 99).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 94 of chapter 99 of the laws of 1907 is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 94. In contracting for any public work or the purchase of any
4 supplies or materials involving an expenditure of **[\$1,000.00]**
5 **\$2,500.00** or more, for such city or by or for any of the city de-
6 partments, sub-departments or municipal officers not embraced in
7 a department, or by or for special commissions or boards, unless
8 otherwise provided for in this act, proposals for the same shall
9 be first advertised for in 2 or more daily or weekly newspapers
10 published in such city, for not less than 3 nor more than 20 days
11 and for not less than 3 insertions of such advertisement. Contracts
12 for expenditures of the city moneys for any public work or for the
13 purchase of supplies or materials for any department of less than
14 **[\$1,000.00 and more than \$200.00]** **\$2,500.00**, shall be made by city
15 council either at a regular or special session thereof in such man-
16 ner as it may prescribe either by resolution or ordinance, but every
17 such contract shall be approved by the mayor, or, if disapproved
18 by him, by $\frac{5}{8}$ of the entire members of city council. **[Contracts**
19 **for public work or for the purchase of supplies or materials for**
20 **any department involving \$200.00 or less may be entered into by**
21 **the commissioner of any department, and such contract, upon the**
22 **signing of a memorandum thereof by any such commissioner, shall**
23 **in all respects be binding upon such city.]**

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
