AN ACT concerning railroads and amending R. S. 48:12-101.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 48:12-101 is amended to read as follows:

2 48:12-101. Tickets for passengers, except excursion tickets or  
3 tickets sold at reduced rates, shall be good **[until used]** for 6  
4 months. Tickets sold at reduced rates shall be good and entitle  
5 the holder to passage for a limited number of days only after the  
6 date of issue thereof, which limit shall be clearly stated upon the  
7 ticket. *\*This act shall not apply to such tickets sold prior to the*  
8 *effective date of this act.\**

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*

1 1. R. S. 48:12-101 is amended to read as follows:

2 48:12-101. Tickets for passengers, except excursion tickets or  
3 tickets sold at reduced rates, shall be good **[until used]** *for 6*  
4 *months.* Tickets sold at reduced rates shall be good and entitle  
5 the holder to passage for a limited number of days only after the  
6 date of issue thereof, which limit shall be clearly stated upon the  
7 ticket.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

## STATEMENT

This bill would amend R. S. 48:12-101 which provides that intra-state tickets for railroad passengers, except excursion tickets or tickets sold at reduced rates, shall be good until used; in other words, shall be valid indefinitely. AMTRAK tickets are valid for 6 months. This bill would make both time limits uniform.
