AN ACT concerning education, and amending section 18:15-43 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

3 1. Section 18:15-43 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 18:15-43. (A) The boards of education of schools established
6 under the provisions of section 18:15-39 ***[or]*** *of this Title in*
7 *any county of the third class with a population not less than 60,000*
8 *nor more than 100,000, according to the 1960 Federal census, and*
9 *the boards of education of schools established under the provisions*
9A *of* section 18:15-40 of this Title, shall receive pupils from other*
9B *districts so far as their facilities will permit, provided a rate of*
9C *tuition not exceeding the cost of such education is paid by the*
9D *sending districts.*

10 (B) The board of education of any county vocational school
11 district referred to in paragraph (B) of section 18:15-41 of this
12 article and the board of education of any other school district
13 within the county thereof are each hereby authorized and em-
14 powered to undertake and to enter into agreements with respect
15 to the attendance at schools of the county vocational school district,
16 of residents or pupils of such other school district who are students
17 attending the schools of the county vocational school district and
18 as to the payments to be made or the rate of tuition to be charged
19 on account of such students. The payment or rate of tuition per
20 student shall be 50% of the pro rata annual cost of the operation
21 and maintenance of the county vocational school district remain-
22 ing after deduction from such cost of all amounts of aid received
23 by the county vocational school district or the county thereof on
24 account of such district or credited thereto from the State of New
25 Jersey or the United States of America or agencies thereof, but

1 excluding from such costs any amounts on account of required pay-
1A ments of interest on or principal of bonds or notes of the county
1B issued for the purposes of such district. The annual aggregate
1C amount of all of such payments or tuition may be anticipated by
1D the board of education of the county vocational school district and
2 by the board of chosen freeholders of the county with respect to
3 the annual budget of the county vocational school district. The
4 amounts of all annual payments or tuition to be paid by any such
5 other school district shall be raised in each year in the annual
6 budget of such other school district and paid to the county voca-
7 tional school district.

8 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1967.
