AN ACT concerning marriages, and amending section 37:1-13 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New*  
2 *Jersey:*

1 1. Section 37:1-13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-  
2 lows:

3 37:1-13. [The Chief Justice and each Justice of the Supreme Court, the  
4 Chancellor and each Vice Chancellor, each circuit court judge, and each  
5 judge of the court of common pleas,] Each judge of the County Court, re-  
6 corder and police justice and mayor of this State, and every minister of  
7 every religion, and judges of the criminal judicial district courts in counties  
8 wherein such courts are or may be established, and judges of the juvenile  
9 and domestic relations courts in counties in which such courts are or may be  
10 established, are hereby authorized to solemnize marriages between such per-  
11 sons as may lawfully enter into the matrimonial relation; and every re-  
12 ligious society, institution or organization in this State may join together in  
13 marriage such persons as are members of such society, institution or organi-  
14 zation, or when one of such persons is a member of such society, institution  
15 or organization, according to the rules and customs of the society, institu-  
16 tion or organization to which they or either of them belong.

1 2. This act shall take effect September fifteenth, one thousand nine hun-  
2 dred and forty-eight.

1 1. Section 37:1-13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as fol-

3 37:1-13. Each judge of the County Court, recorder and police  
4 justice and mayor of this State, and every minister of every religion,  
5 and judges of the criminal judicial district courts in counties wherein  
6-8 such courts are or may be established, and judges of the juvenile  
9 and domestic relations courts in counties in which such courts are or may be  
10 established, are hereby authorized to solemnize marriages between such per-  
11 sons as may lawfully enter into the matrimonial relation; and every re-  
12 ligious society, institution or organization in this State may join together in  
13 marriage such persons as are members of such society, institution or organi-  
14 zation, or when one of such persons is a member of such society, institution  
15 or organization, according to the rules and customs of the society, institu-  
16 tion or organization to which they or either of them belong.

1 2. This act shall take effect September fifteenth, one thousand nine hun-  
2 dred and forty-eight.
