1 AN ACT concerning appropriations by counties and municipalities  
2 to the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial <sup>1</sup>[Fund] Foundation<sup>1</sup>, and  
3 supplementing chapters 23 and 48 of Title 40 of the Revised

6 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the*  
7 *State of New Jersey:*

8 1. The governing body of any county may annually appropriate,  
9 funds in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial <sup>1</sup>[Fund in  
10 the Department of the Treasury, established pursuant to section 4  
11 of P.L.1985, c.494 (C.52:18A-208),] Foundation<sup>1</sup> in support of the  
12 development, construction and maintenance of the Vietnam  
13 Veterans' Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center.

14 2. The governing body of any municipality may annually  
15 appropriate funds in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial  
16 <sup>1</sup>[Fund in the Department of the Treasury, established pursuant  
17 to section 4 of P.L.1985, c.494 (C.52:18A-208),] Foundation<sup>1</sup> in  
18 support of the development, construction and maintenance of the  
19 Vietnam Veterans' Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center.

20 3. This act shall take effect immediately <sup>1</sup>and shall be  
21 retroactive to January 1, 1990<sup>1</sup>.

1 **AN ACT** concerning appropriations by counties and municipalities  
2 to the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Fund, and supplementing  
3 chapters 23 and 48 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the  
6 *State of New Jersey*:

7 1. The governing body of any county may annually appropriate,  
8 funds in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Fund in the  
9 Department of the Treasury, established pursuant to section 4 of  
10 P.L.1985, c.494 (C.52:18A-208), in support of the development,  
11 construction and maintenance of the Vietnam Veterans'  
12 Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center.

13 2. The governing body of any municipality may annually  
14 appropriate funds in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial

17 development, construction and maintenance of the Vietnam

**STATEMENT**

24 This bill permits the governing bodies of counties and  
25 municipalities to annually appropriate funds in support of the  
26 Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Fund, established in the  
27 Department of the Treasury, in support of the development,  
28 construction and maintenance of the Vietnam Veterans'  
29 Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center.

30 The provisions of this bill allow counties and municipalities to  
31 demonstrate support for the heroic efforts of all those New  
32 Jersey residents who fought in the Vietnam conflict, and to honor  
33 the memory of all those who gave their lives in defense of their  
34 country, by providing financial assistance to the New Jersey  
35 Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Committee for the development  
36 and operation of an appropriate memorial to those individuals.

The Assembly Veterans and Military Affairs Committee reports favorably Senate, No. 44 (1R).

This bill permits the governing bodies of counties and municipalities to appropriate funds, on an annual basis, in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation to aid in the development, construction and maintenance of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center in Holmdel.

The bill is retroactive to January 1, 1990.

The Senate Community Affairs Committee favorably reports Senate Bill No. 44 with Senate committee amendments.

Senate Bill No. 44, as amended by the committee, permits the governing bodies of counties and municipalities to annually appropriate funds in support of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation in support of the development, construction and maintenance of the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial at the Garden State Arts Center.

The committee amended the bill to provide that any appropriation made by a county or municipality to support the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial should be made to the Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation. The committee also amended the bill to make it retroactive to January 1, 1990.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 1992 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review which has been performed.
