AN ACT concerning county detectives and amending N. J. S.
2A:157-3.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 2A:157-3 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:157-3. In counties of the first class there may be appointed
3 not in excess of **[30]** ***[35]*** *50* county detectives, of whom one
4 may be designated chief of county detectives, two **deputy chiefs*
5 *of county detectives, four** captains of county detectives, and not
6 more than ***[six]*** *12* lieutenants of county detectives; their
7 annual salaries shall be fixed as follows: chief of county detectives,
8 not less than \$11,500.00; **deputy chiefs of county detectives, not*
9 *less than \$11,000.00;** captains of county detectives, not less than
10 \$9,500.00; lieutenants of county detectives, not less than \$7,500.00;
11 and other county detectives, not less than \$6,500.00.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

DATED: MARCH 25, 1974

Senate Bill No. 521 allows any county of the first class (Essex, Bergen and Hudson) to increase from 30 to 35 the number of county detectives. The additional five detectives will be appointed to the rank of county detective.
