INTRODUCED SEPTEMBER 17, 1970

AN ACT concerning a plan for the providing and apportionment of insurance coverage in certain cases and supplementing Title 17 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The Commissioner of Insurance ****[shall]**** ***may*** adopt,
2 issue and promulgate rules and regulations establishing a plan for
3 the providing and apportionment of insurance coverage for appli-
4 cants therefor who are in good faith entitled to, but are unable to
5 procure the same, through ordinary methods. Every insurer ad-
6 mitted to transact and transacting any line, or lines, of insurance
7 in the State of New Jersey shall participate in such plan and pro-
8 vide insurance coverage to the extent required in such rules and
8A regulations.

9 Prior to the adoption or amendment of such rules and regula-
10 tions, the commissioner shall consult with such members of the
11 insurance industry as he deems appropriate. Such consultation
12 shall be ***[in lieu of]*** **in addition to** any otherwise required
13 public hearing or notice with regard to the adoption or amendment
14 of rules and regulations.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
