SENATE, No. 3076

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: March 20, 1989

The Senate Education Committee favorably reports this bill without committee amendments.

This bill provides that each local board of education must ensure that posters illustrating choke prevention techniques such as the "Heimlich Maneuver" are prominently displayed in all school cafeterias, faculty dining rooms and all other public school locations designated as places where food is consumed. In addition, each board must have pamphlets illustrating choke prevention techniques available in every school for free distribution to students.

The bill directs the schools to utilize those instructional posters and pamphlets which are prepared by the Department of Health pursuant to P.L.1983, c.488 (C.26:3E-1 et seq.) and requires the Department of Health, through local boards of health, to make those instructional posters and pamphlets available to school districts for distribution to students.

This bill is identical to Assembly Bill No. 3480 [1R] which is currently on second reading in the Assembly.
