1 AN ACT concerning the annual reports of the New Jersey Transit
2 Corporation and amending P.L.1979, c.150.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. Section 20 of P.L.1979, c.150 (C.27:25-20) is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 20. a. The corporation shall, by September 15 of each year, file
10 with the Commissioner of Transportation a report in such format
11 and detail as the Commissioner may require setting forth the actual,
12 operational, capital and financial results of the previous fiscal year,
13 the operational, capital and financial plan for the current fiscal year
14 and a proposed operational, capital and financial plan for the next
15 ensuing fiscal year.

16 b. On or before October 31 of each year, the corporation shall
17 make an annual report of its activities for the preceding fiscal year
18 to the Governor and to the presiding officers and the Transportation
19 **[and Communications]** Committees of both Houses of the
20 Legislature. Each such report shall set forth a complete operating
21 and financial statement covering its operations and capital projects
22 during the year. The report shall also include an account of the on-
23 time performance of rail passenger service, including light rail
24 service, operated by, or under contract to, the corporation, including
25 data for each such passenger line. The report shall provide a
26 detailed discussion of the methodology used by the corporation in
27 measuring on-time performance.

28 c. All records of minutes, accounts, bills, vouchers, contracts or
29 other papers connected with or used or filed with the corporation or
30 with any officer or employee acting for or in its behalf are hereby
31 declared to be public records and shall be open to public inspection
32 in accordance with P.L.1963, c.73 (C.47:1A-1 et seq.) and
33 regulations prescribed by the corporation.

34 d. The corporation shall cause an audit of its books and accounts
35 to be made at least once each year by certified public accountants
36 and the cost thereof may be treated as a cost of operation. The audit
37 shall be filed within 4 months after the close of the fiscal year of
38 the corporation and a certified duplicate copy thereof shall be filed
39 with the Division of Budget and Accounting in the Department of
40 Treasury.

41 e. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, the
42 State Auditor or his legally authorized representative may examine
43 the accounts and books of the corporation.
