AN ACT concerning the operation of certain cemetery companies  
and amending N. J. S. 8A:5-3.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 8A:5-3 is amended to read as follows:

2 8A:5-3. Every cemetery company whether incorporated or  
3 organized prior to or subsequent to the effective date of this act,  
4 is specifically prohibited from engaging, directly or indirectly, in  
5 any of the following activities:

6 a. The manufacture or sale of monuments, markers or bronze  
7 memorials.

8 b. The manufacture or sale of vaults as defined in this act and  
9 the manufacture or sale of private mausoleums or any private  
10 sarcophagus.

11 c. The conduct of any funeral home or engaging in the business  
12 or profession of mortuary science; *provided that crematoriums*  
13 *operated in conjunction with funeral homes prior to December 1,*  
14 **\*[1971]\*** *\*1972\*, are excepted from the provisions of this sub-*  
15 *section.*

1 2. This act shall take effect 30 days following enactment.

1 2. This act shall take effect 30 days following enactment.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to permit certain crematoriums to be  
operated in conjunction with funeral homes.
