PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1976 SESSION

By Assemblymen SPIZZIRI and ORECHIO

AN ACT concerning county police officers, county detectives,
 [and] sheriffs' officers *and investigators sheriff's office*
 under certain circumstances, and supplementing Title 40A of
 the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
 2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Whenever any county police officer, county detective ***[or]*** *,*
 2 sheriff's officer *or investigator sheriff's office* has been conferred
 3 with Statewide police powers and is acting under lawful authority
 4 beyond the territorial limits of his employing authority, he shall
 5 have all of the pension, relief, disability, ***[workmen's]*** *workers*
 6 compensation, insurance, and other benefits enjoyed while perform-
 7 ing duties within said employing county.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets **[thus]** in the above bill
 is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

The sponsor's statement adequately summarizes the objective and main provisions of the bill. The bill is a companion measure to Assembly Bill No. 240. The provisions of this bill are similar to those of Assembly Bill No. 236.

The committee amendments, requested by the bill's sponsor, extends the benefits provided in the bill to investigators in the sheriff's office.
